## September is Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month

The National Ovarian Cancer Coalition reports that I in 78 women will develop ovarian cancer in her lifetime. Ovarian cancer screenings are not performed or detected through a Pap test. Two tests are used to screen for ovarian cancer:

- I) Transvaginal ultrasound (TVUS)
- 2) CA-125 blood test measures the amount of protein called CA-125 in the blood.

Are you at risk for ovarian cancer? Here are factors that increase your risks of ovarian cancer:

- Hereditary Risk
- Menopause
- Obesity or Being Overweight
- Having Children Later in Life
- Fertility Treatment
- History of Breast Cancer

There are several ways to lower risks and prevent ovarian cancer. Speak to your gynecologist to receive more information and discuss your personal plan of action.
