



Testing program for hereditary ATTR (hATTR) amyloidosis

One option for genetic counseling and testing is through Alnylam Act®. Patients may now schedule a genetic counseling and testing appointment by phone or video. Genetic counselors will review your symptoms and testing options. If you meet the eligibility criteria for genetic testing through Alnylam Act®, a test can be ordered for you.

How can I initiate the process?



Setting Up the Appointment

Call **1.888.475.3128** to schedule a phone or video call with a genetic counselor.



Pre-test Consultation

A genetic counselor will review your family health history and discuss any symptoms you may be experiencing. Together, you will discuss if genetic testing is right for you.



Easy Ordering

If testing is appropriate and you choose to proceed, a licensed healthcare provider will order a genetic test and send a sample collection kit directly to your home.

- Sample collection may include either a saliva or cheek swab sample
- Return your sample to Invitae for testing by using the prepaid envelope in your collection kit



Result Consultation and Ongoing Care

Within 10-21 days of your genetic test, a genetic counselor will call you to share your genetic test results and explain what they may mean for you and your family.



Alnylam Pharmaceuticals sponsors no-charge, third-party genetic counseling and testing for individuals who may carry one of the 120 or more gene variants known to be associated with hATTR amyloidosis.

- While Alnylam provides financial support for this program, tests and services are performed by independent third parties
- Healthcare professionals must confirm that patients meet certain criteria to use the program
- Alnylam receives de-identified patient data from this program, but at no time does Alnylam receive patient-identifiable information. Alnylam uses healthcare professional contact information for research and commercial purposes
- Genetic testing is available in the U.S. and certain other countries. Genetic counseling is only available in the U.S.
