PREVALENCE

Worldwide, prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer in men and the fourth leading cause of cancer-related deaths.¹

SCREENING

The diagnosis of prostate cancer is based on a biopsy of the prostate.³ Screening for prostate cancer may include a test of prostate-specific antigen (PSA), which can be elevated when a disease is present, or a digital rectal exam.⁴ Most prostate cancer is diagnosed while men are asymptomatic.⁴



men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in their lifetime, **in Black men this figure raises to 1 in 6.**⁵

Black men are 50% more likely to develop Prostate Cancer and twice as likely to die from the disease.^{1,6}
