Traumatic Brain Injury

Each year, nearly two million Americans experience traumatic brain injury (TBI).

TBI results from a forceful blow, bump, or jolt to the head or body. Causes include falls, gunshots, and car accidents.

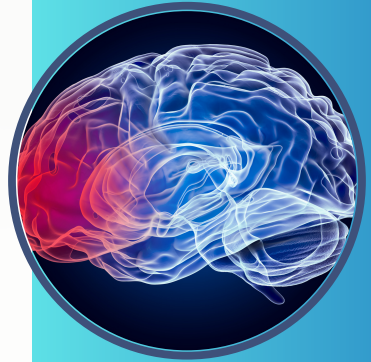
Some types of TBI can cause temporary or short-term problems. More serious TBI can lead to permanent disability. Injury may occur immediately or develop gradually over hours, days, or weeks.

Symptoms of TBI include:

- Loss of consciousness
- Headache or dizziness
- Confusion
- Blurred or double vision
- Ringing in the ears
- Nausea or vomiting

Any adult or child experiencing TBI symptoms should seek immediate medical help.
